Immanuel's church and school ministries have operated throughout the school's history (started in 1977) as one ministry, and that close connection we have remains an important and vital one. We strive to coordinate as many ministries, activities, and opportunities as possible, which happens quite frequently with both the church supporting and participating in school ministries and the school supporting and participating in church ministries.

The best way to describe our ministry at a 10,000 foot level would be that we are theologically conservative and open in practice and application. We approach Scripture very conservatively and recognize the tremendous freedom our Lord gives to us when it comes to living out the Gospel. Some relevant examples would be that we have two different styles of worship including taking our contemporary service outdoors during the months of July and August (<http://church.immanuelloveland.org/about/worship>), and a variety of outreach and activities (such as working with two lower income neighborhoods near us, having weekly men's movie nights, etc.). We value having children, youth, and adults all worshiping together as the Body of Christ. We are in the process of transitioning to new mission and vision statements, which will be around these three words: Love, Learn, Live.

Immanuel is in year nine of being in our new facility that was part of a 10-year relocation process, and what a blessing it is! (<http://church.immanuelloveland.org/about/our-story>) We are on 25 acres of land in a very visible location along the main corridor between Loveland and Fort Collins. There is room to grow and room to dream.

In addition to our school staff, we have an amazing and dedicated staff of people who give specific leadership in the areas of children's ministries, youth ministries, worship and music ministries (<http://church.immanuelloveland.org/about/meet-our-staff>), and all that supports our ministries with facilities, technology, finances, education, and pastoral care. While staff members have specific areas of focus, all staff members work together for the common good of the entire ministry of our church and school.
