#### General:

State of Colorado Director Qualified

Certified in CPR, First Aid, and Medication Administration

Responsible for maintaining all Licensing Rules & Regulations (CO Dept of Human Services, Division of Child Care)

Reports to the School Committee regarding enrollment, staff issues, and other important information monthly, or as needed

Works with treasurer to follow budget

Manages and delegates duties as needed

Creates and fosters an atmosphere of positive Christian guidance for children and staff

Maintain rapport with parents and families

Answer ministry, curriculum, procedure, health, and safety questions

Develops goals and objectives

Manages day-to-day school activities

Answers and returns phone calls, emails, and website request forms

Maintains website and Facebook page

Responsible for advertising

Orders and maintains materials, equipment, and supplies (including snack food)

#### Staffing:

Hires and terminates employees

Recommends staff's salaries/hourly wages to the Committee

Orients new staff members

Conducts monthly staff meetings (or as needed)

Evaluation and review of staff

Provides staff development opportunities

Works with staff to plan curriculum and school events

#### Enrollment:

Takes potential parents on tours, follow up after

Enrolls students, including creating and distributing all required paperwork

Accurate record keeping, including billing

Collects and deposits tuition
