Nothing new here. Rodney Stark, author of "The Rise of Christianity," focuses one toward the Greco-Roman period; a time when abortions often took the life of the mother as well.

Seneca held that infanticide was acceptable and commonplace. Plato and Aristotle promoted infanticide. Stark writes that the earliest known Roman legal code, established in 450 B. C., "permitted a father to expose any female infant and any deformed or weak male infant."

In today's culture, infanticide occasionally takes place even though alternatives are available. Unwanted children are dumped into trash containers or

disposed of by other means instead of being surrendered to safe places or being placed for adoption.

Early Christians frequently rescued children who had been left out in the open. What a beautiful, caring example of the third phrase of the District Focus, "Live the

As we live out our baptism, we may have the opportunity to serve in a teen pregnancy center, provide a room in our own home when a mother-to-be has been rejected by her parents, mentor a young mother who knows little about

parenting or will be challenged to adequately provide for her child.

Our care and concern will embrace the spiritual dimension when guilt and/or shame engulfs an individual who has made poor choices. It presents opportunity to speak of God's grace, mercy and love; to speak of His Son who gave His life for us; and to connect someone to the Church.

Consider what it must have been like for the Virgin Mary in her journey to motherhood. In the face of wagging tongues and a future husband who needed assurance from an angel, she endured and kept the faith. She gave birth to the One through whom all things were created, God's own Son embedded in human flesh. Marvel of marvels!

Praise God that in Him, the One who is Truth, we have not only physical life; we have new life with Him now and for all eternity! Knowing these truths, God grant you courage and strength to "live the faith" in the culture of the 21st century!
