- Firstly, get ye and your entire family to a church who proclaims Christ crucified and teaches the Scriptures in their truth and purity, and who administers the Sacraments rightly. Our Lord is a God of means. He does not leave us with mere spiritual notions, but is bodily present every day in our baptisms, and every Lord's Day in the Eucharist. Since God is really there, we should be, too! This is inherently pro-life, and the most important thing to receive and share together with our littlest neighbors, our children.
- 2. Find local <u>Pregnancy Resource Centers</u> to donate, volunteer and pray for. Invite representatives of PRCs to your church to speak to your congregations, learn what they need, and build relationships.
- 3. Share local or <u>national organizations</u> designed to help single, expectant mothers with education, work, therapy, bills, and child care.
- 4. Consider donating or volunteering at <u>Maternity Houses</u> or hosting an expectant mother.
- 5. Consider adoption or donating to those who desire to adopt and struggle with the financial burdens of its process. Lobby for better laws and means for stable, loving families to adopt.
- 6. Make people aware of the Safe Haven Laws and any <u>Safe Haven baby boxes</u> in the area.
- 7. Join <u>area Marches for Life</u> with your local churches to continue to be emblems of the Gospel.
- 8. Pray with and for those struggling with Life decisions. Show them that there is hope, support and joy in bringing forth children into the world. Show them that people are ready to help take away the fear of the many practical matters of their futures. Pray for the women and men (and extended family members) who've chosen abortion. Pray for their healing and reconciliation in Christ. Show them hospitality and compassion.

Just as Christ forgave from the cross, "Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do," so too, may we recognize that no matter the sins, we need this life-giving absolution, too. Jesus repents, or turns us, from our sins through convicting us of the law we've failed to uphold. May all be convicted that God did not create death, so neither should we ever delight in it. We rejoice that we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ, the righteous one, who is the author, creator and sustainer of life and faith in Him. Thanks be to God for the overturning of Roe! We have much work to do, but our Lord has given us His strength to do it well.
